JAX Naval Hospital

A hospital located in Jacksonville, Florida. Before their healthcare laundry was cleaned and processed on WRC's campus, it was processed in Albany, Georgia! In August 2022, JAX Naval Hospital, an AbilityOne contracted healthcare facility, was officially part of WRC. On a weekly basis, JAX services 4 different companies: Jacksonville Health Clinic, Mayport, Jacksonville Naval Hospital, and Kingsbay out of Georgia. In 2023 alone, the AbilityOne contracted employees serving at WRC have processed over 218,253 pounds of healthcare laundry for Jacksonville Naval Hospital and our other services around the Southeast.

Nashville VA Medical Center

The Nashville VA Medical Center is home to two of our AbilityOne contracted employees, Zach Segroves and Markeysha Mixon! This hospital provides primary care and specialty health services. Markeysha and Zach are part of a 6-person team that is responsible for the linen management and distribution at the Acute Care department of the VA hospital. This team helps maintain PAR (Periodic Automatic Replacement/Replenishment) levels for each hospital department and ensures that the appropriate types/amounts of healthcare linen are ordered each day. This year alone, this 6-person team has distributed over 2 million pounds of clean linen to over 30 different hospital departments/end points in the Nashville area.

Alvin C. York Veteran's Administration Medical Center

Alvin C. York VA Medical Center, located in Murfreesboro, TN, is part of the Tennessee Valley Healthcare System. It provides primary care and specialty health services, including addiction and substance abuse treatment, mental health care, recreational therapy, laboratory services, and more!

Through the Ability One Program, one of the largest sources of employment in the United States for people who are blind or have significant disabilities, WRC employs Linen Technicians like George Bain who helps maintain PAR (Periodic Automatic Replacement/Replenishment) levels for each hospital department and ensures that the appropriate types/amounts of healthcare linen are ordered each day.

This year alone, George and the teams working in Nashville, Murfreesboro, and Ooltewah will distribute over 2 million pounds of clean linen to over 30 different hospital departments/end points in the Tennessee area.

We want to highlight the employees working in Murfreesboro and honor each of them for all of their dedication and hard work serving Murfreesboro but also WRC!
