

Across all of our AbilityOne contracted employee locations, we have seen a lot of hard work and dedication!

Our AbilityOne contracted employees have consistently displayed a strong work ethic and a deep commitment to their jobs. They take on challenging tasks with enthusiasm, and they are always willing to go above and beyond to ensure that our customers are happy with the services we provide. We are incredibly grateful for the contributions that our AbilityOne employees make to our organization every day, and we are committed to supporting them in any way we can.

We wanted to highlight our employees for all of their hard work in 2023:

- For our **JAX Naval Hospital**, they service 4 different companies across Florida and Georgia. In 2023 alone, the AbilityOne contracted employees serving at WRC have processed over 218,253 pounds of healthcare laundry for Jacksonville Naval Hospital and out other services around the southeast.
- For our Nashville VA Medical Center, we have a team of six individuals including 2 of our own contracted employees! They're responsible for the linen management at the Acute Care department of the VA hospital. This team helps maintain PAR (Periodic Automatic Replacement/Replenishment) levels for each hospital department and ensures that the appropriate types/amounts of healthcare linen are ordered each day.
- The Alvin C. York VA Medical Center in Murfreesboro, TN is part of the Tennessee Valley Healthcare System. It provides primary care and specialty health services, including addiction and substance abuse treatment, mental health care, recreational therapy, laboratory services, and more! This year alone, the teams working in Nashville, Murfreesboro, and Ooltewah will distribute over 2 million pounds of clean linen to over 30 different hospital departments/end points in the Tennessee area.
